- Our fiscal year runs concurrent with the calendar year.
- The profit and loss statement you have today is through November 30, 2025
- This report has divided events into income generating and non-income generating. Non-income events are listed as an expense.

Income Generating

- We have two events listed as generating income:
 - Annual Golf Tournament - \$6399 down \$2363 from 2024
 - Putting Contest – \$380.62 up \$222.38 from 2024
- This year our member contributions netted \$10,621, down \$175 from 2024
- Golf Tournament
 - o Golf Tournament income of \$17,145 and expense of \$10,746. (Net \$6399)
