- Our fiscal year runs concurrent with the calendar year.
- The profit and loss statement you have today is through November 30, 2024
- This report has divided events into income generating and non-income generating. Non-income events are listed as an expense.

## Income Generating

- We have two events listed as generating income:
  - Annual Golf Tournament - \$8,672
  - Putting Contest – \$158.24\$xxx
- This year our member contributions netted \$10,796
- Golf Tournament
  - o Golf Tournament income of \$20,775 and expense of \$12,102.24. (Net \$8,672)

## Non-Income Events
