Thank you for helping to end hunger in our community! Your non-perishable foods and monetary contributions are greatly appreciated! Over \$1390 in donations were made. In addition Friends made a donation of \$750 to the Food Bank.

Treasurer's Report

- Our fiscal year runs concurrent with the calendar year.
- The profit and loss statement you have today is through September 30, 2023
- For this report I have divided events into income generating and non-income generating. Non-income events are listed as an expense.

Income Generating

- We have two events listed as generating income:
 - Closest to the Pin - \$\$213.01 and
 - Putting Contest – 339.96
- This year our member contributions netted \$10,386.66
- Although we cancelled our Golf Tournament it still produced significant income. We still have some loose ends to deal with. On the income side we just received a donation from Tito's for \$1,000. and are in process of trying to obtain a refund for the \$2,737.50 in pro-shop credits we had purchased for tournament prizes. On the expense side everyone who has requested a refund for tournament fee pre-payment should have already received a check. I have set up a contingent liability of \$2,525. for the 22 members and 7 non-members who had pre-paid tournament fees but have not responded to our request for disposition. I will hold that contingent liability open for another 60 days before closing our books for the fiscal year.

Non-Income Events

- We had business expenses of \$483.33
- We recently purchased bulbs for Daffodil Day for \$475. which does not appear on the September Statement. That will increase the expenses for projects to \$763.92
- That will leave us with a cash balance at the end of this month of \$42,530.64

Membership

We have a total of 241 members as of the end of September (82 new) for a total of \$11,333. for an avg. membership of \$47.02 compared to last years total of 199 members with an average membership of \$48.39
